1. The nominee must be a member of CQA/ACC in good standing for at least two years prior to being nominated. Circle one: YES / NO
2. The nominee must be a Canadian citizen or have landed immigrant status for at least three years. Circle one: YES / NO
3. The nominee should have displayed a technical mastery of the art of quilting. Give examples:

4. The nominee should by example encourage good design and creativity in the field of quilting.

5. The nominee must have exemplified qualities that have inspired others to become involved in quilting skills/craft/art.

6. The nominee should have held a responsible position in a quilt-related organization.

7. The nominee should be a person who instils respect for the quilt maker and who has been successful in encouraging the public to appreciate quilting as an art form.

8. The nominee may be one or more of the following: quilter, teacher, author, researcher, historian, collector, or editor of a quilting publication.

9. The nominee should have been clearly supportive of CQA/ACC for a significant period of time. (E.g. Enthusiastically promoted CQA/ACC, volunteered or contributed to the newsletter or attended conferences, etc.)
