Canadian members of the Professional Association of Appraisers-Quilted Textiles, and certified through the American Quilter's Society, will be providing professional insurance appraisals services during Quilt Canada 2010 in Calgary.

Why have your quilts appraised for insurance purposes?

- **Your quilt was damaged when your basement flooded – will your insurance cover its replacement?**
- **Do you worry that the quilt made for the bride and groom will be appreciated, or will it end up in as a dog blanket?**
- **How do you prove the Double Irish Chain for sale at the thrift shop was the one stolen from you car?**
- **How does the quilt you purchased from a well-known fibre artist compare to the oil painting hanging on the wall beside it?**
- **Is the quilt on your bed your Grandmother gave you a 'blanket' or a valuable antique?**
- **How do you ensure your heirs will respect the significance of your quilting legacy?**

All these questions and more can be answered with insurance replacement appraisals...

Half hour appraisal appointments may be booked in advance during these show hours.

Display quilts can be appraised while hanging, but please arrange for an appointment! Not going to be there but your quilt is, don't despair arrangements can be made!

The cost for insurance replacement purposes is \$50 per item, with a portion returned to CQA/ACC. All appraisal fees will be paid directly to the appraiser, by cash or cheque. The in-depth professional appraisal report will be mailed directly to the client within one month of the show closure.

All appraisals are by appointment only.
