Banff/Lake Louise Day Trip

Travel past bountiful vistas, scenic foothills, and breathtaking landscapes as we journey west toward Canada's first national park. In Banff National Park, experience the Cave & Basin National Historic Site. See Bow Falls, the Upper Hot Springs, Lake Minnewanka, and Banff and possible wildlife sightings while journeying throughout the area. Travel via gondola to the Top of the World view on Sulphur Mountain. Shop along Banff Avenue where local artists sell their wares alongside designer fashions and symbolic souvenirs. Drive up Tunnel Mountain to Surprise Corner for a spectacular photo opportunity.

From Banff, the journey continues west to Lake Louise, 'the jewel of the Canadian Rockies'. See Chateau Lake Louise, Victoria Glacier and Mount Victoria. On this tour, you will be exposed to one of the most spectacular mountain environments! A trip never to be forgotten! Lunch at leisure. 8 - 9 hours.

City of Calgary and Canada Olympic Park

Discover Alberta's 'Heart of the New West - Calgary!' This half-day tour will give you an overview from past to present, historic origins at Fort Calgary, Inglewood - through to Calgary's modern cityscape. See Eau Claire Market, China Town, the Calgary Tower, Glenbow Museum, City Hall and Olympic Plaza, Calgary Stampede Grounds, Pengrowth Saddledome - home of the Calgary Flames, and many other sights.

Canada Olympic Park, site of the 1988 winter Olympics, is a must see! You will visit the Olympic Hall of Fame and Museum and see a panoramic view of the City as we drive by the 90 metre Ski Jump Tower, Ice House, bobsled, luge and skeleton sled track. The last stop will be the Olympic Oval where speedskaters race on the fastest ice in the world. 4 hours.

Drumheller - Canadian Badlands and The Royal Tyrrell Museum

Imagine a time when the land was a tropical plain dominated by dinosaurs and flying reptiles! Journey back to this mystical era to experience prehistoric life preserved in stone, while witnessing beautiful vistas of modern farmlands and vast plains. Stop at Horseshoe Canyon for a spectacular view of geographical formations carved in the earth. From here, enter into the picturesque Red Deer River Valley - formed during the last Ice Age 12,000 to 15,000 years ago - where J.B. Tyrrell first discovered the skull of an 'Albertosaurus' dinosaur in the late 1880's. Before boarding the Bleriot Ferry - one of the few cable ferries in the province - venture past the Orkney Hill View Point, a sheer drop to the Red River Valley below. Continue along the historic Dinosaur Trail, past Horseshoe Canyon and the world's largest 'Little Church'. Journey down the Hoodoo Trail to see the Hoodoos and the Suspension Bridge. No Drumheller visit is complete without a visit to the world famous Royal Tyrrell Museum, one of the largest paleontological museums on the planet. Opened in 1985, the museum is a primary prehistoric research station and exhibition center. Step inside the doors and enjoy a visit millions of years back in time. 8 - 9 hours.
