Supply List

This class is designed to have fun and play with many different ways to embellish your quilts so the supply list is **all optional** and as it is a class to learn different techniques and applications, we will be playing around with Scraps of black or dark coloured fabrics—these can be made into anything you wish after class, so bring:

10-12 little quilt sandwiches 7 inches square- this means a front square cut 7 inches, batting cut 7 inches and a backing fabric cut 7 inches, spray basted or pinned together. Bring several 7 inch squares of fabric not basted together as well to play with. (Dark colours work best to show off techniques)

- Pencil and pen
- lightweight bobbin thread

Equipment:

- Sewing machine with zigzag, and free motion capabilities
- Couching foot Optional - an open toe embroidery foot will work as well
- Free motion or darning foot
- Sewing machine needles. My favourite needles for all threads are Topstitch 80/12 and 90/14 as they accommodate many different threads
- Any fancy threads you wish to try and/or ones you have had problems using and need troubleshooting
- If doing bobbin work, a separate bobbin case is recommended. We will also be doing my way of "bobbin barf" where there is no need to purchase a new bobbin case-*everyone* can do this
- Small rotary mat, cutter and ruler
- Basic sewing supplies, pins, needles, seam ripper, etc

\$15.00 kit fee -kit includes "Stuff to play with" — foils and several adhesives, Angelina fibers and film, use of my paint sticks, threads and yarns for couching and bobbin work.
