PETPOURRI (Janome) Workshop 101 Supply List

Supply List for Thread Painting your Pet or "Critter":

1. A picture of your pet or critter printed on plain printer paper in colour and also printed on Photo Transfer Fabric in colour
2. Bobbin thread in a colour that would match your project- ie if your critter is dark then a dark charcoal or black- if your critter is lighter in colour a neutral beige or grey.
3. Top Threads to match your critter- for example -a short shiny coat on your pet would require shiny threads such as rayon or the new polyesters- a duller coat or shadows in your picture a cotton works. All weights work- 50 weight, 40 weight and 30 weight keeping in mind the thicker the thread the quicker you can fill in and all coarser coats on animals work best with thicker threads- at least a 40 weight. Look closely at your paper printed picture to determine colour of the coat for thread choices.
4. 8 inch by 10 piece Heavy weight of tear away stabilizer
5. Topstitch needles in 90/14 and 100/16
6. Small Scissors for clipping threads and cutting out your "face"
7. 8 by 10 inch piece of wool batting

8. Monopoly thread in smoke colour for dark animals- clear for lighter coloured animals
9. Background Fabric that you want to place the thread Painted face on
10. Backing and Batting in a size to accommodate your project size
