## **FREEFORM BOTANICAL QUILTING MADE EASY (Janome) Workshop 110 Supply List**

**Fabric;** Good quality 100% cotton for sampler (Whole Cloth) .8 meter (7/8 yard) for top. Plain or tone on tone.

1 m (1yard) for backing. You can use the same as the front or a print for the back.

.3 METER (1/3 yard) binding (Not needed at time of class).

PLUS

.6 meter (2/3 yard) for test sandwiches

A minimum of three 10 inch test sandwiches (plain fabric front, batting and backing) for use in setting machine tension and test stitching patterns.

### **Thread;**

One 50 weight cotton plus One 40 weight rayon

### **Batting**

36 "square (1.0 meter / 1 yard) of Tuscany Poly or Hobbs Heirloom batting for whole cloth sampler.

PLUS

.3 meter (1/3 yard) for test sandwiches.

### **Needles.**

75/11 and 90/14 Quilters Needles

90/14 Topstitch Needle

You will likely only use a couple of these needles but as everyone moves their hands a little differently this will give us some options to help you achieve good quality stitching.

### **Additional Supplies**

Sketch pad and pencil or medium tip felt pen.

Quilting Gloves

Supreme Slider Sheet

Marking tool such as a Frixion heat removable or blue water erase that is clearly visible on your chosen fabric. (Please test prior to class to be sure that it will also erase easily.)

Thread snips or sharp scissors

Safety pins

### **\*Please Note**

We will be pin basting only.

Please have your test swatches cut and layered prior to class.  
We will mark and layer your sampler at class.
