PERFECTING HAND APPLIQUE Workshop 303 Supply List

Two FQ of background fabric (can be any color - do not use batik, although you may bring batik for experimenting. Be careful your fabric doesn't have a layer of pigment on it as that is difficult to stitch through)

Two FQ of contrasting fabrics for the applique - (again no batik and no fabric with pigment)

Paper scissors

Applique fabric scissors - preferably SHARP to the POINT small scissors.

Regular fabric scissors

Thread

- any color thread (50 weight) for basting

- lightweight thread (60 - 100 weight) for applique. Bobbin weight thread, silk thread are two good choices. Bring a neutral color (khaki works great) and one to match one of your applique FQs

Thimble (if you use one to sew with)

Embroidery floss to match (or contrast or both) of your applique FQs

Pencil
