## **DANCING WITH YOUR FEED DOGS DOWN (Janome) Workshop 401 Supply List**

Fat quarter of a fabric for your background sky/water ( oranges, purples, burgundy work for sunrise sunset- project is small and easy to complete so trees will be less than 11 inches high....remember blue sky is blue water, orange sky is orange water, purple sky is purple water....

- Fat quarter of something dark for your "tree" fabric
- 12 inches of a fusible product such as Heat and Bond or Wonder Under- has to be a fusible that is on paper -not parchment- as the parchment will give away before you can cut out the tree-or you can use white freezer paper and glue to fuse (both will be explained and why I use each method and when)
- Optional-Scraps of a dark medium for rocks, land in foreground or island rocks in water. Greys, brown or purples- depending on your background sky- grasses for foreground-Be adventurous with this!
- white school glue to glue down foreground, rocks, etc..
- Threads-Black-or colour to match tree colour in cotton or polyester
- Optional-Black bobbin weight thread polyester thread (or pre-wound polyester bobbins)
- Size 80/12 ,90/14,100/16 topstitch sewing machine needles

- Heavy weight Tear away stabilizer (big enough to back your tree and anything else you are thread playing) I suggest at least .5 of a meter
- .5 meter of white freezer paper
- Basic sewing kit-pins, seam ripper, small scissors-both paper and fabric, quilting gloves for free motion sewing, if you wish
- Rotary cutter, 6 x 24 inch ruler, and cutting mat
- Scraps of fabric and batting to practice stitches and tension (about placemat size pieces)
