NEW WAYS TO HEXIES:

English Paper-less Piecing by Machine (Janome) Workshop 406 Supply List

You may choose to make a single 5-fabric hexagon ring, a complete Grandmother's Flower Garden quilt top measuring 55 ½" x 71", a scrappy hexie bed quilt, or an English paper pieced pattern of your choice. If you are using your own pattern, please consult it for the yardage requirements.

Yardage Single Hexagon Sample:

Centre Dark Colour 1 - 4" x 3" piece

Round 1 Medium Colour 1 - 4" x 18" piece

Round 2 Light Colour 2 - 4" x 40" piece

Round 3 Medium Colour 2 - 6" x 40" piece

Round 4 Dark Colour 2 - 6" x 40" piece

Yardage Grandmother's Flower Garden:

Centre Dark Colour 1 - 0.25 metre

Round 1 Medium Colour 1 - 0.9 metre

Round 2 Light Colour 2 - 1.6 metres

Round 3 Medium Colour 2 - 2.6 metres

Round 4 Dark Colour 2 - 2.0 metres

Yardage Scrappy Hexie, Single Bed Size:

1 set of 42 x 2-1/2" strips

Yardage Scrappy Hexie, Double/Queen Bed Size:

2 sets of 42 x 2-1/2" strips.

Other Supplies:

To make hexie templates:

- 1 meter freezer paper (which must be removed) - approx. 130 hexies/meter

OR 1 meter of Apliquick interfacing * (which can stay in) - approx. 130 hexies/meter

OR precut iron-on interfacing hexies * (which can stay in) - packages of 100

- Water-soluble glue stick *

- Apliquick rods * (optional but helpful; will have sets available in class to try)

Thread:

Monofilament (Invisible) thread * with a neutral bobbin

OR Different colored threads to match each fabric

- Pencil *

- Scissors *
