What Can You Do?

GENERAL HELP: This means ironing, squaring quilts for binding, cutting batting and backing to size, filling bobbins, assembling blocks to go into a quilt, smiling.

LONG ARM QUILTING: If you know how to use a long arm quilting machine, please sign up for that.

SEWING: sewing blocks into quilt tops or sewing bindings and labels onto quilts, sewing binding into long strips or quilting the smaller quilts using a domestic machine.
